

## *Frontier Collegiate Campus Services*

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### Home Away From Home

- Each residence area has 2 area counsellors—they are the primary support of student care, safety and wellbeing
- 2 Head Counsellors—one always on shift
- 2 Shift Heads—one always on shift
- Students from fly-in communities return home for Christmas & Spring Break
- Road accessible communities are bussed home often during the school year
- Each residence area is equipped with a TV lounge, washrooms, showers, kitchen area and laundry area for student use
- Laundry services are available from Monday – Wednesday where laundry is done for students
- Cafeteria provides breakfast, lunch, supper and night lunch to all residence students that follow the Health Foods Policy
- There are weekly shopping and movie trips for Flin Flon or The Pas. Other field trips are taken throughout the year (i.e.; camping, fishing, etc.)
- Community facilities such as the skating arena and curling rink are available to students.
- Local spiritual and wellness opportunities
- Part time jobs are available in the cafeteria and youth centre

### Health & Wellness

- Social Worker available during school hours
- Health Care worker available during the day and on-call in the evenings

- Addictions Foundation of Manitoba employee comes to the school two days per week
- Public Health Nurse visits the school once a week
- The public health nurse also sets up a time to give students their immunization needles
- Representatives from Mental Health and the Women's Resource Centre are also available
- Student Support Specialist is available to students from 1:00 p.m. – 8:45 p.m. on weekdays
- Weight room open evenings and weekends

### Education & Programming

- Wide range of compulsory courses available and a wide variety of optional courses
- Dual credit courses offered in partnership with University College of the North for Carpentry Program
- Adapted and modified programming for students who require transition into regular classes
- Special Services, English and Math Consultants/Coaches – resource for teachers in the area of student program planning
- Resource Teacher/Guidance Counsellor available during school hours
- Speech/Language Pathologist and Educational Psychologist are available
